Conference Tourism



Cultural Tourism



The cultural wealth of Messinia, which consists in remains of a unique archaeological interest (Mycenaean domed tombs), archaeological sites (ancient Pylos, Temple of Epikourios Apollo, Ancient Messini), museums, historic monuments (castles, historic city centers), Byzantine churches and monasteries, samples of traditional architecture (towerhouses of Mani), the culture and the routes of the Olive tree and a rich contemporary cultural life (Dance Festival, festival Miden, cultural events) is a challenge for the modern tourist with cultural interests, who asks for knowledge and valuable experiences.

Health Tourism

Apart from the existing health infrastructure (hospitals, clinics and health centers), Messinia offers two medical units, specialized to address specific health problems and restore patients, which can be combined with holidays for the patient and the persons accompanying him/her.



Marine Tourism



The sea surrounding Messinia forms bays and coves that are ideal for yachting and anchoring points for a pleasant break for swimming and relaxation. The two marinas (Kalamata and Pylos) and coastal settlements, with jetties, offer a convenient and safe anchoring, combined with all kinds of services and facilities. The circumnavigation of Messinia is part of the circumnavigation of the Peloponnese, which offers a unique experience for sailors and generally for marine tourists. Messinia, through the port of Kalamata, is also interesting as a stopover of cruise ships sailing in the Eastern Mediterranean, a stopover off the beaten track. Messinia is also ideal for all forms of water sports and maritime activity (sailing, windsurfing, diving, etc.)

Nature Tourism-Ecotourism

Messinia offers the tourist a number of different beautiful landscapes, usually scattered with olive groves and wild vegetation, unique protected areas (lagoons, rivers, uninhabited islands, the unique mountain of Taygetos) and a very interesting flora and fauna. Looking back on "Protected Areas", one can find all the specific data, associated with their natural environment, flora and fauna, but also with organizations working to protect them and the tours offered for ecological observation.
